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Processing

The processing and material temperature should be between 68-77°F (20-25°C).

The hardener component will darken as it ages. It is recommended that dry nitrogen be used to blanket the material to prevent oxidization and from becoming moisture contaminated.

Both the hardener and resin will freeze when exposed to temperatures below 32°F. If this occurs, place containers in an oven at 120°F, agitating every 45 minutes until the materials are re-liquefied. It is important to note that temperatures exceeding the recommended heating conditions or failure to agitate will cause excessive localized heat and potentially damage the product.

Storage
