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Processing

The processing and material temperature should be between 68-77°F (20-25°C).

For best results, de-air the material prior to casting, then pressurize to 60 psi until cured. However, if pressure cannot be used, this material has been designed for vacuum degas only. OC-5313 can be easily buffed when cured.

Agitate the hardener and resin before use to ensure that the formula is homogenous.
