

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Processing

The processing and material temperature should be between 68-77°F (20-25°C).

Formulated for hand-batch equipment. For best results, de-air material prior to casting, then pressurize to 60 psi until cured. The hardener component will darken as it ages. It is recommended that dry nitrogen be used to protect the material from oxidizing and being moisture contaminated.

Agitate the hardener and resin before use to ensure that the formula is homogenous.
