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Processing

The processing and material temperature should be between 68-77°F (20-25°C).

For best results, place the poured tool into a pressure vessel and pressurize to 60 psi until cured. This material will slightly darken as it ages. It is not recommended that custom color-matching be incorporated into this system due to this slight color change that transpires.

Agitate Hardener and Resin before mixing to ensure a homogenous formulation.
